Dr. Mitchell is Director of the Marion E. Wade Center and Assistant Professor of Theological Studies at Wheaton College, Illinois. He received a MA from Wheaton College and a PhD from the University of St. Andrews, Scotland, where his concentration was Historical Theology. He serves as Book Review Editor for *Seven: An Anglo-American Literary Review*, a journal published annually by the Wade Center on its authors. He lectures widely on J.R.R. Tolkien and C.S. Lewis as well as on the other authors of the Wade Center, which include Owen Barfield, G.K. Chesterton, George MacDonald, Dorothy L. Sayers, and Charles Williams.

Marjorie Lamp Mead is Associate Director of the Marion E. Wade Center, Wheaton College, Illinois. Her primary Lewis related publications include on *A Reader's Guide to Through the Wardrobe and A Reader's Guide to Caspian* (both volumes co-authored with Leland Ryken, Professor of English Wheaton College), *Brothers and Friends: The Diaries of Major Warren Hamilton Lewis* (co-edited with Clyde S. Kilby), and *C.S. Lewis: Letters to Children* (co-edited with Lyle W. Dorsett), as well as numerous contributions to *The C.S. Lewis Encyclopedia*. She has given presentations throughout the United States and Great Britain on the seven Wade authors. She is also Managing Editor for *Seven: An Anglo-American Literary Review*, a journal published annually by the Wade Center on its authors. She has a B.A. in English Literature and an M.A. in Biblical and Theological Studies, both from Wheaton College (thesis topic: *Making Sense of the Universe: Dorothy L. Sayers and the Way of the Intellect*).
